UP A LAZY RIVER WITH LAWMMAKERS

The Alliance to Restore the Kankakee did some river lobbying on Wednesday, taking U.S. Reps. Jerry Weller (left) of Morris and Tom Ewing of Pontiac on a river tour of the Mokence wetlands area near the state line. The purpose was to show the congressmen firsthand the problem of sand filling the river. A \$175,000 appropriation for the Corps of Engineers to study solutions to the sand problem has passed the House this year under Ewing's sponsorship and Weller's support.
